## User Moment

European crypto service providers faced a hard deadline to secure MiCA registrations if they wanted passporting rights across the bloc. Product leads spent quarters building consent flows, remuneration disclosures, and whitepaper repositories tailored to each asset type.

## **Product Surface**

Stablecoin issuers must maintain fully backed reserves with monthly attestation, while CASPs need incident-reporting portals and travel-rule integrations. Vendors surfaced dashboards combining blockchain analytics with KYC hits to give compliance teams a single operating pane.

## **Ecosystem Reaction**

Some startups geofenced EU users temporarily, but larger exchanges converted compliance readiness into a selling point, courting banks that suddenly had clarity to partner. Law firms launched MiCA readiness packages covering governance, custody controls, and complaint handling.

## **Execution Lessons**

Treat regulation like product rollout: schedule phased migrations, train support teams on new disclosures, and publish public-facing status trackers so users know what services are temporarily disabled during upgrades.
